**Dr. Gabriel Wollner will be joining the Philosophy & Economics Programme in May 2012 as a lecturer in political philosophy.**

Gabriel Wollner holds a BA in Philosophy, Politics and Economics (PPE) and an MPhil in Political Theory from the University of Oxford and recently completed his PhD in Philosophy at University College London. He is currently a McCloy Scholar at the Kennedy School of Government at Harvard, where he will also be a Graduate Fellow at the Edmond J. Safra Center for Ethics before joining the Philosophy and Economics Programme in Bayreuth in 2012. His research interests are in contemporary moral and political philosophy, and the application of these inquiries to various issues in public

policy. His doctoral thesis, 'Egalitarianism with a Human Face' defends a responsibility-catering version of egalitarianism and he is currently setting out on a new project on obligations of justice under conditions of less than full compliance. His most recent publication is 'Framing, Reciprocity and the Grounds of Egalitarian Justice' in *Res Publica: A Journal of Legal, Social and Moral Philosophy*.
